### Uniforms:

The uniforms for the Teenagers from Mars consists of Crimson jerseys and Blue pants. The uniforms used to be white jerseys with blue pants -- but over time, the blood from their opponents has saturated the cloth to a beautiful Crimson.

## Background:

Originally a team from the English isle, the London Harliquins were your typical Human Blood Bowl team. Mostly made of general Lineman positional players, this team dominated throughout the Albion Northern Premiere League. With a winning record from 2490 until the year 2500. This team was the winner of of Albion Championship trophy 2 years running and working on a 3rd straight, until their star blitzers - a set of twin brothers Wilhelm and Jacob Grimm - had a fatal accident on the way home from a celebration banquet in downtown London after defeating the Elfheim Eagles 45 to 7! The twins were passing through a dark alley and were pummeled to death by Eagles fans.

After the loss of the Grimm brothers, the 2501 season was sub .500 for the first time in over 10 years. This trend continued for the 2502, 2503, and 2504 seasons. With the lack of success on the field, the fans soon grew sick of their lovable losers. The owner of the Harliquins threatened to disband the entire organization.

After the failure of a season in 2504, Harliquin owner Warren Peace sold the franchise to Undead team owner Adam Baum. Mr. Baum was at the time also the owner of the Champions of Death organization. After consulting coach Tomolandry the Undying -- Adam Baum disbanded the "Harliquin" franchise stating that "the image of the Harliquins is not something I want associated with the Champions... things are going to change over this post season"

During the preseason training, this now relatively unknown group of Blood Bowl misfits began a new training regiment with the aid of the Champions of Death's infamous necromancer -- Nagash. (According to legend, Nagash was a priest in the courts of the land of Nehekara, and after learning Dark Magic from prisoner Dark Elves, developed his own twisted form of Magic which he termed Necromancy. This magic gave him the power to command the dead, and ultimately he cast a powerful spell from his tower, with the intent of raising all the dead of Nehekara, thus creating a titanic army of mindless Undead.)

Seeing the success of the Champions of Death, the former Harliquin players convinced team captains Lord Byron Quigley and Sir Heinrich Taylor to hold a meeting with their new coaching staff. The meeting started off with the pleasantries of getting familiar with coach Tomolandry, moving on to uniforms, and further moved to what makes the Champions so fearless on the pitch. The coach explained to Byron that his players sign a pact in conjunction to their team contract. This pact states that, if signed

by the player, the team necromancer will take away the pain from training, increase their endurance during matches, and turn them into blood thirsty players ready to WIN!

The next day the captains had a meeting after practice with the rest of the team. They explained how well the team trainers and necromancer take care of the Champions of Death. Lord Byron told the huddled mass of players about how they could play harder, feel no pain, and play with the same hungry intensity as the Champions do! They all agreed that they would sign the pact and form a new team under the same management team as the Champions, minus coach Tomolandry of course... but as everyone knows, all great things come at a price.

A press conference was called by owner Adam Baum to announce the creation of this new team before the preseason began. Baum settled in front of an ABC (Association of Broadcasting Conjurers) crew, Harliquin fans, coaching staff and players to make the announcement.

"Ladies and gentlemen. It is my great pleasure to announce the expansion of the Champions of Death organization... we will be forming a new team for all of you fans to cheer for! You know some of these stars already.. but for those you may not know -- (pointing to team captains, Quigley and Taylor) are going to play like ANIMALS this season!" (he said through his crooked smile) He continued, "As we have already discussed with the players, this new contract of theirs is a two part commitment. Not only are you committing to this organization - but you are also committing to the changes you are going to experience by being a member of this group! Welcome to the team boys... Day turned to night.. and night passed into the next day. The squad arrived at the Stirland Hurricanes' stadium to get ready their preseason opener. As they entered the locker room, the stench of alcohol from the night before still lingering on most of their breath.. players beginning pre-game rituals and uniforms being donned for the first time in what felt like a century. The

captains began to hype up the team with their pep talks.. "we take the field today hungry for blood.. you represent the best of the best in the entire league!" They took the field and fought a tough match.

As the preseason continued.. the players noticed odd changes to their sleeping pattern, or rather lack there of. Their appetites were decreasing more and more with time and they were staying up for days, if not weeks, on end. The captains noticed that they were more alert than ever before and their energy had increased ten fold during the night.. but what could all of this mean?

The team held a meeting with their coach and team necromancer to discuss concerns. The team issues were brought up in a boisterous uproar... "THESE are the changes you were referring to??", they shouted. Now looking around the room seeing many players with: skin rotting off, bones breaking through their skin, limbs missing... all with no sense of pain or discomfort. The team captains now resembling a monster straight out of a B rated horror film: covered in hair, razor like claws, and sharp teeth!

Adam Baum spoke, "This was ALL covered in your contracts, along with the necromancer of our team taking care of your becoming Undead -- we promised to bring back some of your missing stars from last season.. and some new editions as well. Without making you hold your breath too long - let me introduce the newest editions to your team.." A door opened into the meeting and 4 people walked in, 2 players recognized and 2 wearing hoods.. "Men, let me introduce the newest Ghouls to join the the, Joey Image and Jerry Only - these guys are coming from the Champions of Death, so make them feel welcome here." Meanwhile, the two hooded players remained behind the coaching staff waiting in silence.

"It's been about a year since these two have been on a blood bowl pitch.. but the other half of your contract stated than Nagash the necromancer would do everything in his power to return this two to your team. Back from the dead - these two Wights will be a welcomed addition to your team! Welcome back Wilhelm and Jacob Grimm!" Everyone on the team had heard stories about Nagash and how powerful his dark magic was.. but could this be real? Not sure whether to scream in horror or cheer with delight, the team sat there silent with their fallen brothers returned to them from the grave.

"With these new editions to the team, we now have a full roster," coach Kaline said in a very matter of fact tone. "With this Necromantic team, we

are ready to fight off anyone who crosses our path. Tonight is our last preseason game as a rag tag group of misfits... Next week's season opener against the Albion Yellowjackets - you will officially be... THE TEENAGERS FROM MARS!"

A new team was born.

Over the next few seasons, games were won and games were lost. The need for stronger players came and went as well. The team's Igor and Necromancer used parts and pieces from various players that were killed during matches to construct Flesh Golems for the Teenagers.. although this Golems were rarely used during matches for fear they would fall apart!

Current Season:

This has been a tough season for the Teenagers. With many new teams joining the league - these opponents seem to best the Teenagers From Mars most often than not. The season closer at the Ghouls Night Out was a lack luster tournament showing - although placing in the middle of pack was fine for these less than intelligent monsters!
